

The Controller provides, for the purpose of observing fairness and transparency with regard to the Data Subjects, this notification of Data Subject on the processing of personal data pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of the Regulation of the European Parliament and the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (hereinafter referred to as the "Regulation"); and Section of Act of the NA of SR No.18/2018 Coll. on the Protection of personal data and on amendments to certain acts under the title

## **PRINCIPLES OF PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION**

### **Purpose of personal data processing - Contact form:**

As part of the activity, personal data is processed in the client's register for the purpose of sending an answer to the question asked.

**Scope of Data Subjects:** natural persons – clients.

**List of personal data:** name, surname, email, address, telephone number.

**Legal basis for the processing of personal data:** consent of the Data Subject.

**Categories of recipients:** entities to which a special regulation grants the power to decide on the rights and obligations of natural persons: courts, law enforcement authorities.

The transfer of personal data to third countries is not performed.

**Time limits for deletion of personal data:** maximum 6 months (in case of fulfilment of legal obligations or legal claims of the Controller according to valid legislation).

### **Automated decision making, including profiling is not performed.**

The Data Subject shall have the right to withdraw the consent to the processing of personal data concerning them at any time. Withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of the processing of personal data based on consent prior to the withdrawal; the Data Subject must be informed of this fact before giving their consent. The Data Subject may withdraw the consent in the same manner as they granted it.

### **Data Subjects for whom personal data are processed for specifically defined purposes may exercise the following rights:**

Right to request access to their personal data - Right to correction of personal data - Right to deletion of personal data - Right to restriction the processing of personal data - Right to object to the processing of personal data - Right to transfer their personal data - Right to file a complaint with the supervisory authority, i.e. the Office for Personal Data Protection of the Slovak Republic.

The rights of the Data Subject are specified in more detail in Articles 15 to 21 of the Regulation. The Data Subject shall exercise these rights in accordance with the Regulation and relevant legislation. The Data Subject may exercise their rights by means of a written request or by electronic means. Where the Data Subject requests information to be given orally, the information may be provided, if the Data Subject has proven their identity.

**Slovak Artificial Intelligence Society** has taken all reasonable personnel, organizational and technical measures to maximize the protection of your personal data in order to minimize the risk of misuse. Pursuant to our obligation under Article 34 of the Regulation, we notify you, as Data Subjects,

that if, as a Controller, we violate the protection of your personal data in a way that is likely to lead to a high risk to the rights and freedoms of individuals, we will notify you of this fact without undue delay. Legislation and the related ways of processing your personal data may change.

If we choose to update this policy, we will post changes to our website and inform you thereof. We will notify you beforehand if this policy is to be fundamentally changed or when we are required to change it by law. We ask that you to read this policy carefully and regularly review it when communicating with us or using our website.
